GUIDELINES FOR A SAFE SUMMER

The goal of the Turn-Around Summer Program is to provide enjoyable activities in a safe, clean, positive and Christ-centered environment for all participants. The guidelines are reviewed with the entire camp at the beginning of each week and will be referred to when necessary.

SAFE and POSITIVE means Participants:

- Follow program guidelines and rules at all times
- Use equipment safely
- Stay within camp boundaries
- Remain with their program group and inform leaders of their whereabouts (i.e. restroom)
- Play games safely so as not to hurt themselves or others
- Are responsible for their own actions

ENJOYABLE means Participants:

- Are courteous and respectful to all participants and staff
- Use non-offensive language at all times
- Support and be considerate of the feelings of others
- Solve problems in a fair and peaceful manner
- Include other in their activities
- Play cooperatively without bullying or teasing others

CONSEQUENCES for inappropriate behavior are handled as follows:

1. First Incident - Verbal warning
2. Second Incident - 10 minute time-out of activity
3. Third Incident - Removal of privileges and/or suspension and a note sent home to parents
